- 1. Stay Engaged
- 2. 2. Experience discomfort
- 3. 3. Speak your truth
- 4. Expect and accept non closure

Connection is richer when risks are taken

Agreements can guide thinking

If something is being said that makes you uncomfortable you can respond in Thank you for speaking your truth. It is good to recognize discomfort.

Definition of design (slide 6)
