Sched (This tool will be available through 12/31/20.)

Sched is the online platform where you will be able to access all LIVE conference meetings as well as all conference panel and workshop videos.

Every conference attendee will need to create their own personal Sched account and a unique password in order to access conference videos. Ideally, you should complete these steps by November 10th.

A link to set up your Sched login will be emailed to you within 24 hrs of your completed registration. Be sure to check your spam.



After your initial login, go to www.sched.com/login to sign in with your email and password.

Once you have access to your Sched account, you can edit your profile, "pin" events to customize a list of workshops and panels you want to view, and find bios and contact information for conference speakers.
