Finland, Germany, Korea, Puerto Rico, Sweden, Taiwan, and other areas. A National Art Education Association Distinguished Fellow, her professional achievements have been acknowledged through international, national, state, and university awards and recognitions, including the Kenneth Marantz Distinguished Alumni Award from The Ohio State University where she earned her Ph.D.
